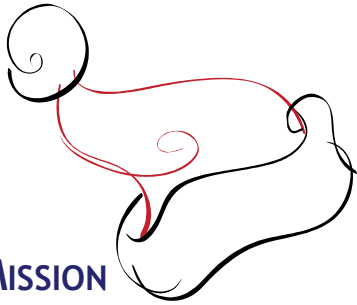

What we do to help:

- An after-work wellness exercise program tailored to the workplace environment.
